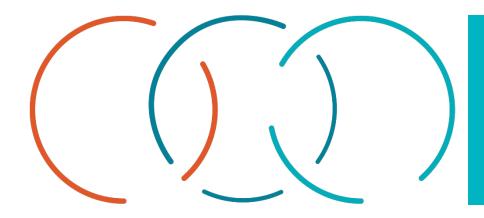


Onboarding Working Group
