Specification Guiding Principles

- Build trust and consistency around the use and sharing of open source
- Less is More
 - Deliver necessarily and sufficient requirements of a "quality" compliance program
 - Focusing on meaningfully significant pain points (based on actual practice)
 - Avoid boiling the ocean



Specification Guiding Principles

- Focus of the what and why (avoid the how and when)
 - Embrace implementation of different practices to solve same problem
- Avoid providing best practice and/or legal advice for the spec






Curriculum
